In these plant species are found 90 woody species and 28 species of herbs divided into 93 genera and 48 botanical families

The most abundant species belong to the family of:

Asteraceae

Myrtaceae

Fabaceae

Mimosaceae



The vegetation type is dominated by savannas which consist of grasses, shrubs and spotted trees and are most often transition zones to gallery forest





Areas with herbaceous species are highly anthropized thus detrimental to shrubs and trees which are been subject to great anthropogenic pressure.
